
## TESTIMONY



**R**electing on the journey that brought me to a bent knee, clenched fist, teary eyed, which tested and boosted my faith, I cannot but thank God for and loud the authenticity of his word to whoever I'm privileged to share my faith journey testimony with, and to also thank my faith partner (my husband) for walking this journey with me.

So we married December 14, 2019, and in 2020 alone, I had a lot of miscarriages, 4 to be precise (I was that fertile) lol.


One shocking thing about the repetitive pattern was that they all came down same gestation period (5 weeks, 4 days) which



made me more concern, coupled with the fact that I resolved to natural procedure by letting the tissue out itself at home as against D&C— Medical procedure, with excruciating pain that always last for 14-16 days.

January-November 2021, I really did not understand what my body was doing as a woman. For the first time, I lost track of my period and ovulation, was diagnosed with high prolactin, outbreak of white patches and stretch marks.

I stopped being intentional about testing for pregnancy as I never wanted my hope to be dashed because when I bleed, I really couldn't tell if it was a miscarriage or the normal period, cause they all lasted more than usual.



Then came December 2021, I told God to give me a birthday gift, that I want to test "positive" on my birthday which happened 13th January 2022. Glory! 30th of same month came as we were preparing for one of our meetings (Prayer Drill) the recurrent pattern surfaced, told my husband, "Babe I didn't see blood" He responded with a shout "Glory to God" and that was it, we left for the meeting and even led worship.

All through those times we had our word and confession hands-on which we never missed, and most importantly we held on to our joy—we never lived as one who do not have children, we rejoice cause we truly have, and that's the language of faith! You need to see how we conversed with our

children at home.. Lol

We knew our journey was not the medical route, and that we are faith preachers, hence we'll have to be built and furnished for the same thing wherein we'll help others. Anything God cannot give us, no man will.

Came March 2022, I got the word "you'll soon remember when you were praying for what you now have" so I declared a fast for myself which my husband also joined in... .. I wasn't doing it for the sake of "pregnancy" though.


In a service in my church around May before I got to know or confirm I was pregnant, the Lord, through the prophetic words of my pastor, Apostle Muyiwa Areo said "Relax this won't fail" I held on to the word with my confession.

We tested for pregnancy in May 2022 and was positive. Glory to God.

We put our faith to work and it delivered to us our trophy of faith on the 6th of January 2023. Alleluia!

In the journey of faith;

1. You must have a word for it in the Word. You can't confess or lay claim of an inheritance you have no knowledge about.
2. Believe it. Mark 11:23
3. Receive it. Mark 11:24
4. Confess it repeatedly and act on it. You can't get your faith built without repetition. Romans 10:17
5. Patiently wait for the delivery of it. Hebrews 6:12



Doubt, unbelief, worry and anxiety are enemies of faith. Faith is either God does it or God does it! There's no middle point. No alternative!

Watch those you give your attention to. They are either feeding your fear or your faith.

If faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God, fear also comes by hearing and hearing the bad news of people.

Lastly, it is what you say continually that comes to pass in your life not what you say occasionally. Frequency matters in confession.

# OUR SCRIPTURAL *Confessions* AGAINST MISCARRIAGE

**D**uring one of our retreats we discovered you don't confess just anything, so by studies and leading of the Holy Spirit we discovered this Four Scriptural antidotes to Miscarriages – Service, Obedience, Honouring God, and The Fear of God. Thus, we confess this way with the Scriptures that Follow

## **1. I SERVE THE LORD JESUS**

Exodus 23:25-26 (KJV)

25 And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee.

26 There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfil.

## **2. I OBEY THE HOLY SPIRIT ALWAYS**

Deuteronomy 7:11-15

11. Therefore, take care to follow the commands, decrees and laws I give you today.

12. If you pay attention to these laws and are careful to follow them, then the LORD your God will keep his covenant of love with you, as he swore to your forefathers.

13. He will love you and bless you and increase your numbers. He will bless the fruit of your womb, the crops of your land--your grain, new wine and oil--the calves of your herds and the lambs of your flocks in the land that he swore to your forefathers to give you.
